Circular economy

We believe that the transition to a circular economy is an opportunity and an important piece of the puzzle for evolving towards an environmentally friendly society. We contribute to a circular economy in several ways:

- > Using sustainable resources in material selection and product design, while minimising the use of unnecessary raw materials.
- > Sustainable renunciation of environmentally harmful and use of resource-saving packaging materials and methods.
- > Maximising the product life by developing products based on the needs of the end customers.
- > Saving costs and raw materials through separation of individual components by type and maximum recycling ambition of our products.
- > Minimising the use of raw materials through efficient product designs and production processes and by maximising transport efficiency.
- > Reduction in the use of natural resources and raw materials through maximum reuse of materials from manufacturing.
- > Extending product service life and increasing customer satisfaction through systematic product management.
- > Energy reduction through the use of well-insulating and regional building materials throughout the production plant, in restorations and renovations, as well as in all branch offices.
